Impala Platinum achieves 2 million fatality free shifts

Emphasis on safety starting to pay off, says Keith Rumble

Impala Platinum Holdings Limited is pleased to announce that Impala Platinum Limited has just achieved 2 million fatality free shifts across its entire Rustenburg operation, which involves close on 27 900 employees

The last time the entire Impala Lease Area recorded 2 million fatality free shifts was on 26 March 2002. Other major safety achievements currently in force at the Rustenburg operations include 4.6 million fatality free shifts at 4 shaft, 2,8 million fatality free shifts at 8 shaft, 2 million fatality free shifts at 9 shaft and 1 million fatality free shifts at 6 shaft, at Services Division (which includes transport) and at Mineral Processes.
