Implats regrets death of two employees at Marula Platinum

<p>Ticker symbols: JSE: Imp LSE: Ipla ADR: Impuy</p> <p>Website: www.implats.co.za</p> <p>Les Paton 27-11-731-9018 27-82-448-7102</p>	<p>Impala Platinum Holdings Limited (“Implats”) confirms with deep regret that two employees, Messrs Prince Sekgobela (28) and Christiaan du Plessis (26) died in an incident at Clapham shaft at Marula Platinum on Tuesday, 23 October 2007.</p> <p>Says CEO, David Brown: “We are saddened by the loss of our two employees and extend our sincere sympathies to their families, friends and colleagues. “Implats remains committed to its long term policy of “zero harm” and we are pursuing this challenge with vigour”.</p> <p>Following the incident, Marula management has together with the Department of Minerals and Energy’s Principal Inspector of Mines Limpopo region, closed the operations at Clapham Shaft.</p> <p>The closure will enable Marula, together with the inspectorate, to determine the cause of the incident and implement the necessary corrective measures to prevent a similar occurrence.</p> <p>Mining operations at the Driekop Shaft are continuing as normal.</p> <p>[Ends]</p>
